<p>Course offer</p> <div data-bbox="103 537 370 728" style="border: 2px solid red; background-color: yellow; padding: 5px; transform: rotate(-2deg); display: inline-block;"> Online switch if COVID crisis imposes so </div>	<p><u>IN FRENCH:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “Ingénieur”: a 5-year curriculum in Agri-related topics (Agriculture, Life Sciences, Food Science, Marketing and Management). The first 3 years correspond to Bachelor (BSc) level courses, and the last 2 years to Master (MSc) level courses. Incoming students can take courses from Year 3 and 4 (exceptionally from years 2 and 5), according to their language skills and academic background. We recommend taking all courses in the same year to avoid timetable conflicts. <p><u>IN ENGLISH:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • IBC (International Bachelor Certificate): a 2-semester program taught in English, for Bachelor or Master students. Incoming students can come in Semester 1 (focused on Animal Production and Winemaking) or Semester 2 (focused on French Food and Wine), or for the Full Year. No prerequisites. • SSAP (Summer Study Abroad Program): A 4-week on-campus program taught in English, for Bachelor or Master students, focused on European Agri-Culture, European Animal Productions/ Economics and either Food Science or Viticulture and Enology. This is followed by an optional 4-week internship or a 2-week study-tour. Prerequisite: a good command of English.

Linguistic knowledge	<p>“Ingénieur”:</p> <p>Language of tuition: French.</p> <p>B1 level required but B2 level highly recommended (according to CEFRL). Candidates may be subject to a skype interview to assess the level prior to admission.</p> <p>A “French as a Foreign Language” (FLE) course of 30 hours is offered at the beginning of each semester, in order to help students adapt and detect required improvements.</p> <p>IBC:</p> <p>Language of tuition: English.</p> <p>B1 level required but B2 recommended (according to CEFRL). Candidates may be subject to a skype interview to assess the level prior to admission.</p> <p>A “French as a Foreign Language” (FLE) course of 20 hours is offered at the beginning of each Semester (for arriving students): “survival French” for the everyday life, at A1-A2 levels.</p> <p>SSAP:</p> <p>Language of tuition: English.</p> <p>A “French as a Foreign Language” (FLE) course during the on-campus is included in the program (“survival French” at A1-A2 levels, or intermediate/advanced at B1-B2 levels).</p> <p>Some French may be useful for the everyday life, but not compulsory.</p> <p>Semester students also have the possibility to sign up for “French as a Foreign Language” courses during the Academic year within the "Université Fédérale de Toulouse" network (cost = 100 € per module).</p> <p>For more information, please visit https://www.univ-toulouse.fr/des-formations-pour-tous/se-former-en-langues</p>																								
Workload and ECTS available	<p>PURPAN follows the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS).</p> <p>Workload of a full-time PURPAN student = 30 ECTS per semester, that is 60 ECTS per academic year.</p> <p>Specificities for exchange students:</p> <p>“Ingénieur” program:</p> <p>The first 3 years correspond to Bachelor (BSc) level courses: 180 ECTS; the last 2 years correspond to Master (MSc) level courses: 120 ECTS; the curriculum totalizes 300 ECTS.</p> <p>It includes not only courses, but also internships and reports (not always accessible to exchange students); the course offer for exchange students thus varies from 16 to 25 ECTS per semester.</p> <p>Students should verify their Home Institution requirements and check how they can reach their required workload.</p> <p>IBC program: 30 ECTS for Spring 21 Semester</p> <p>SSAP: 9 ECTS for classes + 3 ECTS for Internship = 12 ECTS 9 ECTS for classes + 4 ECTS for 2-week study tour = 13 ECTS</p>																								
Grading System	<p>PURPAN follows the ECTS grading scale. Local examinations are graded out of 20 and are translated into ECTS grades as described hereunder.</p> <p>The pass mark for exchange students is 10/20, unless specified otherwise. Some courses may indeed be validated with ECTS based on attendance (indicated “NC”).</p>

Estimated cost of living	<p>Accommodation (<i>rent + rental insurance</i>) ≈ 300 to 600 € per month</p> <p>Food (3€²⁵ a meal in the university cafeterias) ≈ 200 to 400 € per month</p> <p>Local transport: bus tickets for 31 days - less than 26 years old ≈ 11€ per month - more than 26 years old ≈ 51 € per month</p> <p>Study Abroad / Healthcare Insurance (<i>indicative</i>) ≈ From 30 to 60 € per month</p> <p><i>Leisure + other personal costs</i> ≈ 120 to 150 € per month</p>

Program fees	<p><i>Only for the SSAP: please check with home university; the cost covers board & lodging, some week-end excursions, local travel and insurance. Tuition fees are waived if you come as an Exchange student. It does not cover travel from & to the home country, nor personal leisure costs</i></p> <p>≈ 2600 € in 2020 for the 4-week on-campus program plus the optional internship</p> <p>≈ 4100 € in 2020 for the 4-week on-campus program plus the optional 2-week study tour</p>
Accommodation	<p>We can help students find accommodation upon request and according to the offers received. Our possibilities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ State "CROUS" Residence Halls (according to the quota yearly granted, or according to availabilities for out-of-quota) ▪ Student residences (e.g.: Nexity): according to availability ▪ Sharing a flat with other French/international students (especially during Spring Semester) ▪ Room rents in private housing ▪ Studios or apartments (only a few offers per semester) <p>Otherwise, we provide students with a non-exhaustive list of websites related to accommodation in Toulouse, for their own housing research.</p> <p>NB: for the SSAP program, board & lodging is provided, and included in the program fee</p>
Insurances	<p><u>Compulsory by French law:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Medical & Hospitalisation <p><u>For European students:</u> European Health Insurance Card, or a private international insurance for the whole period of studies.</p> <p><u>For Non-European students:</u> - International Private Insurance for the whole period of studies - and/or Registration with the basic French Social Security scheme "Assurance Maladie", only if you stay more than 3 months</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Personal Civil Liability (also called "third-party damage"): it covers students for body injuries and for material damage caused to a third person. <p>Ecole d'Ingénieurs de PURPAN will register students with its insurance centre MSA (Mutualité Sociale Agricole) for Work Accident: for internships & everyday travel from accommodation to school; for this purpose, students must provide us with a copy of their original birth certificate + its translation into French by an official translator.</p> <p>PURPAN also asks for a Repatriation coverage (medical assistance and repatriation of remains) to the home country.</p> <p>For students renting a room or an apartment, owners usually require a renter's insurance coverage too.</p> <p>For other activities (sports, renting cars etc.), please check insurance requirements.</p>
